Sept. 21st Middle/High School

### Communication Map

Communication Maps design based on information gathered about the student's intentional and functional communication (forms of communication and level of functional communication), possibilities for the future and linking the student to the community.

Sept 28th All ages

### After Personal Futures Planning

Based on information of the student and how they communicate, their energy, and how they communicate functionally and educationally and linking the student to the community.
